Objectives of the Conference

The evolving nature of Global Terrorism will require an integrated response from law enforcement, first responders, hospitals and local community leaders. Future attacks will likely be dynamic, multi-target assaults that challenge conventional response paradigms. Planning and preparation to respond to modern urban terrorism must address the lessons learned at Mumbai, Lahore, Beslan and Virginia Tech. The conference will:

- Develop **emergency plans for the management of victims** during dynamic terrorist attacks.
- Propose **security measures to improve the protection of first responders**, hospitals, and other involved personnel in 4th generation attacks.
- Discuss the unique role of **medical intelligence** in the response to terrorist attacks.
- Discuss **relevant issues in the aftermath of a terrorist attack including medical forensics and short-term and long-term psychological care.**
